

LEARNING OUTCOME

- Relate sense of initiative in career development with proactive career planning
- Demonstrate how a sense of initiative in job-seeking leads to innovative job search strategies
- Carry out career decisions and display a strong commitment to personal and professional growth

AIM OF ACTIVITY

This activity aims to inspire young VET learners to proactively shape their career paths. By creating a vision board, participants will gain clarity on their career goals, fostering a sense of initiative in job-seeking and a commitment to personal and professional growth.

MATERIALS REQUIRED FOR ACTIVITY

- Magazines, newspapers, or printouts with images and words related to career aspirations
- Scissors, glue, and a poster board or large paper
- Markers, pens, and other art supplies
- Flipchart and markers

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Introduction

- Explore the concept of a career vision board and its significance in guiding proactive career planning
- Reflect on the importance of a sense of initiative in career development and how it can lead to innovative job search strategies

Step 2: Vision board creation

- Gather materials such as magazines, scissors, glue, and a poster board

Career vision board

- Dedicated space for articulating broader, long-term career aspirations
- Use images and words to express the ultimate career destination

- Visualise these skills through images or icons

Innovative job search strategies

- Section for creative and proactive approaches to job searching
- Include visuals representing networking, online presence, and distinctive strategies

- Use images or symbols to represent these ideals
