LEARNING OUTCOME

- Define critical thinking
- Explore how critical thinking applied to job-seeking scenarios can be used effectively when preparing for a career
- Integrate critical thinking into job-seeking strategies, influencing career decisions

AIM OF ACTIVITY

This activity aims to cultivate essential critical thinking skills for effective job seeking. Participants will explore how critical thinking enhances their ability to navigate career decisions, influencing strategies for successful job searching. Engaging in this activity will empower young learners to approach their career paths with a well-honed and analytical mindset.

MATERIALS REQUIRED FOR ACTIVITY

- Flipchart or whiteboard and markers
- Critical thinking exercises [see template]
- Pens and paper
- Printed job descriptions/case studies for analysis [see template]

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Introduction to critical thinking

- Define critical thinking and its relevance to job seeking
- Reflect on how critical thinking skills can positively impact career decisions and job search strategies

Step 2: Critical thinking exercises

- Consider the attached template with scenarios that require critical thinking
- Analyse and reflect about the scenarios, fostering your problemsolving skills

Step 3: Application to job seeking

- Consider the templates of job descriptions and case studies [see template]
- Apply your critical thinking skills to assess and strategize effective approaches for the given scenarios

Step 4: Self-reflection

- Reflect on insights gained from the critical thinking exercises
- Reflect on how you can integrate critical thinking into your personal job-seeking strategies

TEMPLATE

Step 1: Introduction

Critical thinking is the ability to analyse, evaluate, and synthesise information to make informed decisions. In job seeking, critical thinking is vital. It empowers individuals to assess job opportunities, align career goals, and navigate challenges. Possessing critical thinking skills enhances the capacity to evaluate complex situations, strategize effective solutions, and make informed career decisions. This skill set positively impacts job search strategies by enabling individuals to adapt, innovate, and stand out in a competitive job market. In essence, critical thinking is the compass guiding proactive decision-making, fostering success in both career development and the pursuit of meaningful employment.

Steps 2, 3 and 4: Critical thinker's career challenge template

Introduction to critical thinking

Critical thinking exercises

• Exercise 1 (scenario):

• Exercise 2 (scenario):

You have identified a job opportunity that aligns with your skills and interests, but the company has mixed reviews online regarding its work culture. Apply critical thinking to determine how you can gather additional information about the company's work environment.

Consider various sources such as employee reviews, industry forums, and networking. Develop a strategy to assess the credibility of the information and make an informed decision on whether to pursue the job opportunity.

Application to job seeking

Job description/case study analysis
1: Marketing coordinator

2: IT Support specialist

You come across an IT Support Specialist position at a well-established company. The role includes troubleshooting technical issues, providing user support, and maintaining IT systems.

3: Project manager

You discover a Project Manager position at a nonprofit organisation focused on community development. The role entails coordinating projects, managing budgets, and collaborating with community stakeholders.

4: Sales representative in a competitive market

You are interested in a Sales Representative position in a highly competitive market. The role involves prospecting new clients, meeting sales targets, and building long-term relationships.

5: Human Resources generalist

Consider a Human Resources Generalist role at a growing tech company. The responsibilities include recruitment, employee relations, and policy implementation.

6: Content Creator for a Start-up Blog

You encounter a position as a Content Creator for a start-up blog. The role involves generating engaging content, managing social media, and building an online audience.

7: Data analyst in an e-commerce company

Evaluate a Data Analyst position in an e-commerce company. The role requires analysing customer data, identifying trends, and providing insights for business improvement.

8: Customer service specialist in a tech start-up

You come across a Customer Service Specialist position at a tech startup. The role involves handling customer inquiries, providing technical support, and ensuring customer satisfaction.

9: Financial analyst in a global corporation

Consider a Financial Analyst position in a global corporation. The role involves financial forecasting, budgeting, and analysis of international markets.

10: Event planner for corporate conferences

Evaluate an Event Planner position focused on organising corporate conferences. The role includes coordinating logistics, managing budgets, and ensuring the success of large-scale events.
